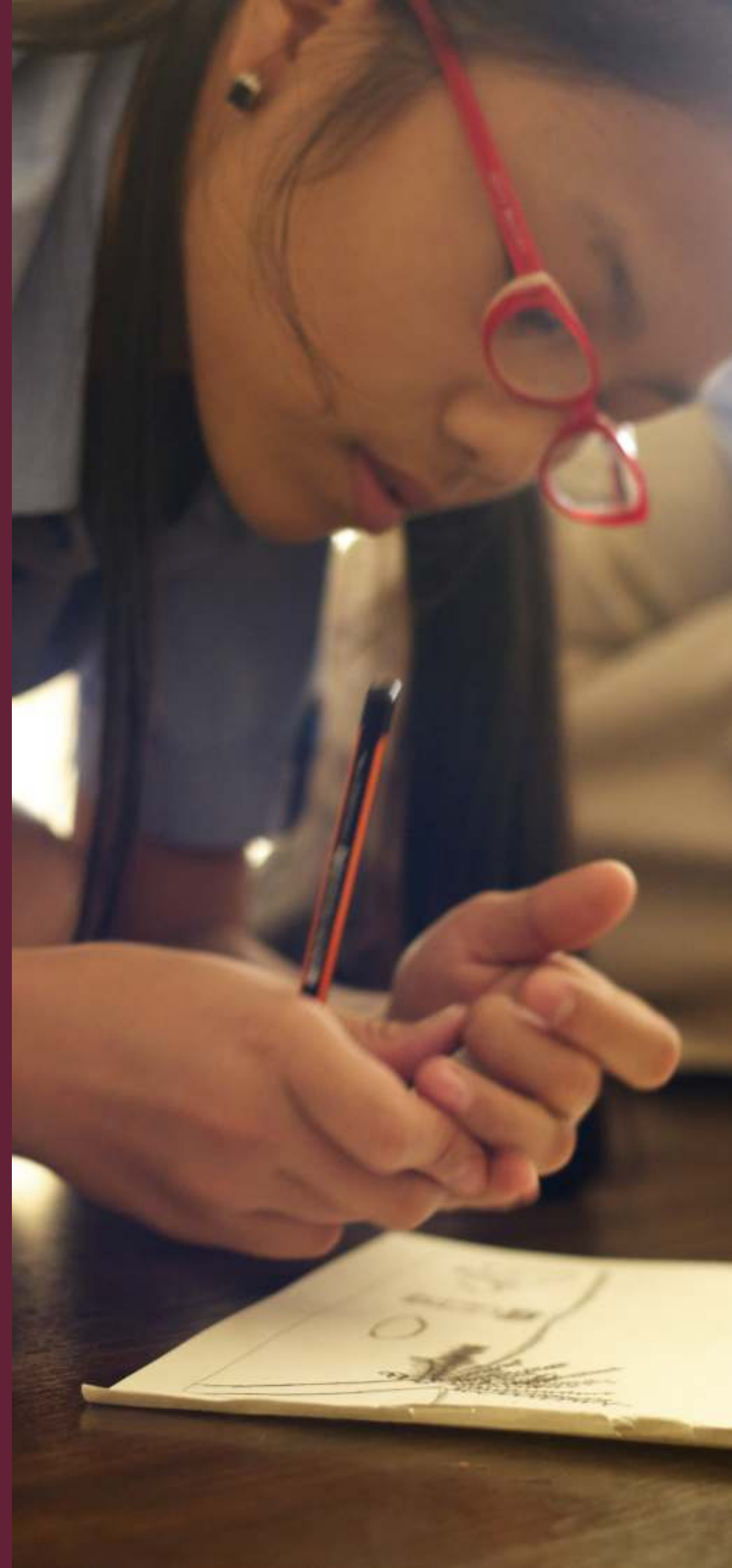

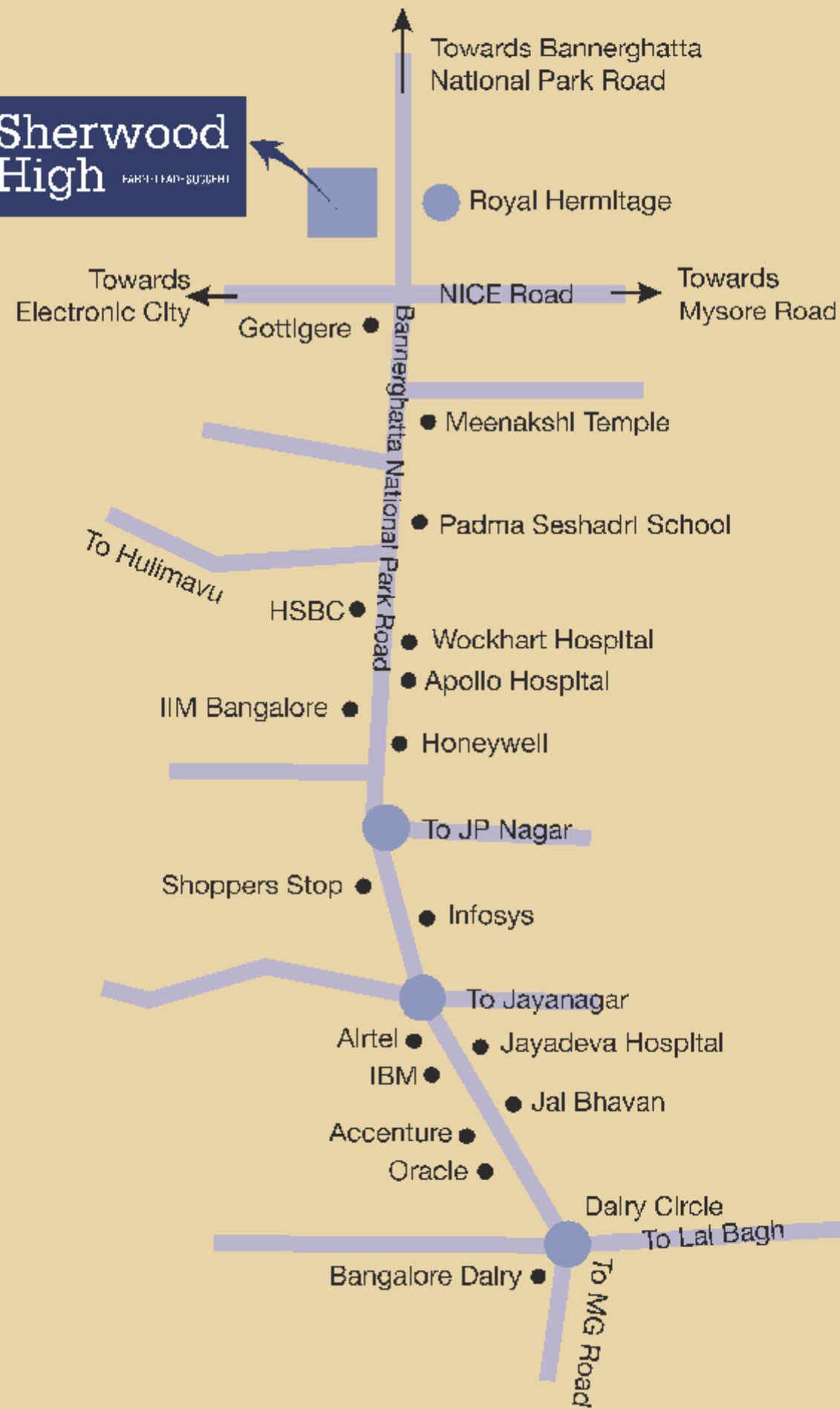
TIME TO SHINE!
